Highlights from Council Meeting on May 15, 2023

Mayor O'Brien recognized the Coast Salish peoples and their traditional territory upon which we gather with gratitude.

COUNCIL RECEIVED THE FOLLOWING DELEGATIONS

- The Regional District of Nanaimo provided information about the RDN Liquid Waste Management Plan amendment.

COUNCIL RECEIVED THE FOLLOWING CORRESPONDENCE

- A request for financial support from the Seaside Cruizers Car Club for the annual Fathers' Day event; funding for 2023 was approved.

COUNCIL RECEIVED THE FOLLOWING REPORTS

- Parksville Volunteer Fire Department update, including call volumes and incident statistics.
- A new policy for City employees as volunteer on-call fire department members; the policy was approved.
- A development variance permit (DVP) and development permit (DP) to facilitate a patio home residential development on the Blenkin Avenue portion of 249 Finholm Street North; staff will provide notice of the intent to consider the DVP, while consideration of the DP is deferred until final consideration of the DVP.
- Recommendations from the May 15 Committee of the Whole meeting; the 2023-2026 Strategic Plan was approved and the associated corporate work plan was amended.
