Highlights from Council Meeting on June 5, 2023

Mayor O'Brien recognized the Coast Salish peoples and their traditional territory upon which we gather with gratitude.

COUNCIL RECEIVED THE FOLLOWING DELEGATIONS

- The Mid Vancouver Island Habitat Enhancement Society provided information on a trout movement study in Shelly Creek and protection of fish habitat and creek flows.
- A request for reconsideration of the remedial action ordered for the unsightly property at 1460 Seaway Drive.

COUNCIL RECEIVED THE FOLLOWING CORRESPONDENCE

- A letter from the Regional District of Nanaimo regarding adoption of "Regional District of Nanaimo Northern Community Sewer Local Service Amendment Bylaw No. 889.79, 2023"; Council consented to the adoption.

- Reaffirmed a remedial action order for the unsightly property at 1460 Seaway Drive.
- Approved a revised Policy 9.2 "Fire Department Honorariums and Standby Pay."
- Accepted a portion of waterfront parkland and payment in lieu of the required balance for the subdivision at 864 Gaetjen Street.
- Issued a development permit at 864 Gaetjen Street to facilitate subdivision.
- Authorized award of the pavement overlay program contract.
- Approved the 2022 Statement of Financial Information (SOFI).
- Renewed the lease agreement for 625 Pym Street.
- Approved the new Council Travel Expense Reimbursement Policy No. 2.31 and amendments to the current Policy No. 7.6.
- Directed staff to request meetings with provincial ministers at the annual UBCM convention in September.
