Highlights from Council Meeting on May 6, 2024

COUNCIL RECEIVED THE FOLLOWING PRESENTATIONS

- MNP LLP presented the City's audited financial statements for the year ended December 31, 2023. The financial statements were approved as presented.

COUNCIL RECEIVED THE FOLLOWING DELEGATIONS

- The E&N Railway Division of Canadian Railway Historical Association gave a presentation regarding the railway water tower.

COUNCIL RECEIVED THE FOLLOWING REPORTS

- Approved issuance of a development variance permit at 133 McMillan Street South to facilitate a greenhouse.
- Approved issuance of a development permit for a single-family dwelling and associated landscaping at 860 Gaetjen Street.
- Received a report on 2023 development cost charge activity.
- Received the final report from the Phil St Luke Standing Committee.
- Received a report on the railway water tower options; staff were directed to investigate relocation of the tower to Victoria.
