Highlights from Council Meeting on December 16, 2024

COUNCIL RECEIVED THE FOLLOWING PRESENTATIONS

- The Parksville Qualicum Beach Tourism Association provided a presentation regarding short-term rentals.

COUNCIL RECEIVED THE FOLLOWING REPORTS

- Received a mid-term report from Mayor O'Brien.
- Approved the confined space rescue services agreement between the Parksville Fire Department and the Regional District of Nanaimo.
- Approved reissuance of a development permit to facilitate a three-storey mixed-use building at 155 Hirst Avenue East.
- Received an interim housing needs report as an addendum to amend the Housing Needs Report previously received by Council in March 2022.
- Endorsed a temporary amendment to Snow and Ice Policy 8.10 for a sidewalk snow clearing pilot project.
- Received a report on the 2025 - 2029 Financial Plan and advanced the bylaw to the statutory process.
- Deferred consideration of proposed Public Waste Receptacle Policy No. 8.25 to February 3, 2025, with input from the Parksville Downtown Business Association and Parksville Qualicum Beach Tourism Association.
