



HIGHWAY 19A 2013 UPGRADE PROJECT
(5330-20-HWY 19A)

PART I - INVITATION TO TENDER

Sealed Tenders marked "Tender for City of Parksville, Highway 19A 2013 Upgrade Project" will be received at the Department of Engineering and Operations at 1116 Herring Gull Way in Parksville, BC, up to 2:00 pm local time, March 8, 2013. Tenders will be opened in public, shortly thereafter. The time of tender closing shall be established by the time shown on the clock used by the City for that purpose.

The work involves the widening and re-construction of approximately 800 lineal meters of arterial roadway, on Highway 19A between Rushton Avenue and Moilliet Street. The works include the installation of traffic signals at the Bay Avenue and Moilliet Street intersection(s); the replacement of water, sanitary, storm sewer mains, streetlights, sidewalks, and other related appurtenances; road reconstruction; landscaping features; and other related surface improvements within the project area.

Tender documents will be available at the Department of Engineering and Operations at 1116 Herring Gull Way in Parksville, BC, after 2:00 pm, February 15, 2013, on payment of \$100.00 including HST. This payment is non-refundable.

Award of the contract is subject to sufficient budget funds being available for the project. The schedule of completion, proposed project superintendent, subcontractors, size of workforce, proposed equipment, and previous experience on other similar projects will all be considered in review and acceptance of tender.

Tenders must be accompanied by the specified Bid Bond, payable to the City of Parksville. The lowest or any tender will not necessarily be accepted. The City of Parksville reserves the right to waive informalities in or reject any or all tenders, or accept the tender deemed most favourable in the interests of the City. Tenders not conforming to the specified requirements may be returned to the Tenderer without consideration.

The City of Parksville reserves the right, at its discretion, to negotiate with any tenderer it believes has the most advantageous tender or with any other tenderer or tenderers concurrently. In no event will the City of Parksville be required to offer any modified terms to any other tenderer prior to entering into a contract with the successful tenderer and the City Parksville shall incur no liability, or costs of, any other tenderer as a result of such negotiations or modifications.
